

Location

Classes for the program will take place at a designated location in Gettysburg. Gettysburg is a small, touristic and famous town and the site of the American Civil War, where the Gettysburg battle took place. It is also known as the place, where Abraham Lincoln delivered his famous Gettysburg Address. The town is surrounded by National Parks and very close to Washington DC and Baltimore.

There are wonderful facilities at the local YWCA suitable for Walkouts, swimming and other student activities during the summer. Students will live with host families, while in town. They can use all the facilities at the local YWCA, including the gym, sport rooms and indoor pool at reasonable price to be negotiated by the institute.

PROGRAM AND DURATION

The program lasts approximately 3 weeks during, which students learn English and visit interesting cities and states in the U.S.A.

Classes will take place in two sessions, one focused on grammar, reading and writing skills and a second one based on communicative activities, which will focus on listening and speaking skills.

Classes will be in the mornings. In the afternoons, students will engage in activities such as, go to the movies, and visit the surrounding areas in a special coach including walking to get a better view of the town and its surroundings. They will have the opportunity to associate with their peers from around the world and the town of Gettysburg, when possible to help them communicate better and practice.





Travels And Excursions

Washington DC

During the weekends, there will be a day trip to Washington DC, to see important Washington monuments, Museums, the World War II Memorial, the White House and many more as time permits.

Maryland

Students will take a trip to Fredrick or Baltimore Maryland, where they will see important and interesting locations.

Pennsylvania

The State of Pennsylvania and Gettysburg, is the location of the program. Besides daily trips to museums and historical monuments in Gettysburg, students will take a special trip to Parks in Pennsylvania, visit Hanover Pennsylvania as time permits and see the surrounding Shopping outlets in Gettysburg and its environs.



New York

On a special weekend students will visit New York City and get the opportunity to see important places like: Times Square, Fifth Avenue, St Patrick's Cathedral, the Metropolitan Museum of Art, United Nations, a ride on the Staten Island Ferry to Staten Island NY, shopping malls and more as time permits.
